For Starters

The Northwest Indiana Oilmen begin their fifth season on Friday in Bloomington. The opener was scheduled to take place on Thursday, but the Oilmen were postponed by rain on opening night for the third straight year. The Oilmen have reached the postseason four consecutive years, but haven't played won a Midwest Collegiate League title since 2012. They return six players from last year's team, the most in franchise history. The Oilmen are 2-2 on Opening Day over their first four seasons. They dropped the season openers in 2012 and 2013, then beat the Snipes 2-1 in 2014 and the Admirals 5-2 to begin the 2015 campaign. This marks the fourth time in five years the Oilmen have begun the season away from Northwest Indiana.

Inside The Oilmen

The Oilmen send 6-foot-4 right-hander Max Siedlecki (New Mexico Highlands / Chicago, Ill.) to the mound to start the first game of the season on Thursday. He joins a list of Oilmen Opening Day starters that also includes Keith Mahler (2015), Jimmy McNamara (2014), Michael Steensen (2013) and Tait Rauen (2012). Siedlecki went 0-6 with a 7.42 ERA during the spring. Thursday will be his first game action since a scoreless inning on April 24.

Inside the Bobcats

Friday marks the return of collegiate summer baseball to Bloomington, resuming the team's rich history that has been on hiatus since 2002. The Bobcats were originally run by legendary Illinois Wesleyan University baseball coach Jack Horenberger. Friday's starter Mitch Weis had an 8.15 ERA in four starts this year at Division-I Illinois State.

Spring Fling

Due to the success of Oilmen players during their spring seasons, the Oilmen will play shorthanded on Friday. Chase Dawson (Valparaiso / Chesterton, Ind.) is the starting second baseman for Division-I Valparaiso, which won 10-7 over Northern Kentucky on Wednesday in the Horizon League Tournament. Dawson, named to the league's all-freshman team, went 3-for-3 in Wednesday's game. In the same game, NKU had an Oilman in its starting lineup, as Brad Bohlen notched a base hit. Valpo split two games on Thursday to stay alive in the tournament. UIC's Chris Baker saw his team's season end on Thursday. Stefano Belmonte is competing in the Atlantic Sun Tournament for Florida Gulf Coast, defeated Kennesaw State 6-0 on Thursday. Tyler Sroczynski is at Trinity Christian, which is competing in the NCCAA National Championships this week in Mason, Ohio, Oilmen manager Adam Enright is an assistant coach at Trinity Christian, so he too will miss Friday's game. Former Lexington Snipes manager Billy DuBois will fill in as Oilmen manager. Four players are finishing prep seasons. Sam Geraci and Richard Yelnick are playing in the NJCAA Division-II World Series for Parkland on Saturday. Blake Cleveland is playing in the MAC Tournament with Central Michigan, which defeated Ball State 4-0 on Thursday.
