For Starters

The Northwest Indiana Oilmen have won back-to-back games to start the homestand and hold a 5-1 record in games played at Oil City Stadium this season. Christian Howell became the first Oilmen starter this year to work into the eighth inning on Thursday night, tossing 7 2/3 dazzling frames with only one run (earned) allowed. The Oilmen prevailed 12-3, defeating Michigan City for the first time this season. Six different Oilmen had multiple hits in Northwest Indiana's most lopsided win since July 20, 2014, an 11-2 triumph over the Zephyrs. The Oilmen picked up the 100th victory in team history on Thursday night.

Inside The Oilmen

After being scratched from Tuesday's scheduled start with an eye infection. Keith Mahler is expected to take the hill on Friday night. Mahler, the only second-year Oilmen pitcher, holds a 4.50 ERA in three starts. His most recent outing came on June 18, when he yielded two runs on four hits over five innings and had no decision in a 4-3 loss to DuPage County. Mahler faced the Snipes on June 7, picking up the win despite allowing four runs on seven hits in a four innings in a rain-shortened 7-4 win for the Oilmen. Josh Turnock picked up his third three-hit game of the season on Tuesday night, becoming the first Oilmen with three three-hit days this season. Only Tyler Sroczynski joins Turnock with more than one three-hit performance.

Inside the Snipes

The Snipes travel to Oil City Stadium carrying a three-game winning streak. The Snipes are playing their best baseball of the season and have climbed into third place in the Midwest Collegiate League. Parkland pitcher Ross Learnard gets the nod from manager Billy DuBois. Learnard holds a 1.62 ERA in 13 innings and has issued six walks and 16 strikeouts. Lexington's leading hitter is Neal Tyrell, who has a .340 average in 13 games.

About the Matchup

The Oilmen and Snipes are set to meet for the fourth time this season, with the Oilmen capturing victories in two of the first three contests. The Oilmen hold a 14-6 advantage in the all-time series between the two teams. The most recent matchups came on June 20 in Lexington, when the two squads split a doubleheader.

Around the MCL

The Oilmen now sit in a first-place tie with DuPage County in the Midwest Collegiate League, technically percentage points ahead of the Hounds. The Snipes join the Hounds and Oilmen as the three MCL teams with winning records. Michigan City hosts Joliet on Friday, while the Vikings and Hounds have the day off. With DuPage County idle on Friday, the Oilmen can take over sole possession of first with a victory. On Thursday, the Hounds and Vikings split a doubleheader, while Lexington defeated Joliet 4-1.
