### Oilmen Split With Hounds At Home

The Oilmen faced the first-place DuPage County Hounds in a doubleheader yesterday, and won the first game 6-3 before dropping the second game by a final of 7-1.

In Game 1, Brett Schneider (3-3) was once again on point for NWI, equaling his longest outing of the season with 6 and 1/3 innings of work. After he allowed two baserunners in the seventh, he gave way Matt Pobereyko, who bounced back from a blown save on Tuesday to record his league-leading fourth save.

The Oilmen jumped on DuPage starter Daniel Will for four runs in the first, including RBI hits by Nick Bartolone, Nick Saldutti and Craig Austgen.

In Game 2, it was the Hounds setting the tone with a big inning, platir four runs in the second off of Danny Pobereyko (0-1). The Oilmen got one run back on an RBI single by Ty Hogan, but were unable to break through against winning pitcher Steve Heilenbach.

With the split, the Oilmen remain in third place, 3.5 games back of the Hounds, and just a half-game behind Lexington, which lost to Rockford last night.

### Hello Again, Sugar Grove

The Oilmen and Zephyrs tangle again tonight, with the Oilmen having revenge on their minds from Wednesday's defeat at Waubonsee Community College. It was the first time NWI had ever lost to Chicago, as they went a perfect 6-0 last season. The two teams will also meet up for a doubleheader on Sunday following an off day on Saturday.

#### <u>Justin Huisman</u>

Justin Huisman is in his second summer as the manager of the Northwest Indiana Oilmen, having led the team to the MCL title last summer. He is also the head coach of the Trinity College Trolls baseball team. Huisman played collegiately at the University of Mississippi from 1997 to 2000, where he earned honors as an infielder and a closer. At Ole Miss he broke the single-season saves record his sophomore year and surpassed his own record the next year. He also broke the career saves mark for UM.

Manager Second Year Overall Record: 53-28 (including playoffs) Huisman came out of school after his junior year at Ole Miss, getting drafted in the 15th round of the 2000 MLB draft by Colorado. In four seasons, he jumped four levels with the Rockies, notching 78 combined saves between Low-A, High-A and AA. He was traded to Kansas City in 2004. Though starting out in AAA Omaha for the Royals, Huisman was quickly called up to the big leagues and made his major league debut on April 25th. He went on to pitch 25 innings for Kansas City that season. Before sustaining an arm injury, Huisman posted three more seasons in AAA and one season for the Newark Bears (NJ) in the independent Atlantic League. He currently resides in Crown Point, Indiana, with his wife Julia and step-daughter Isabella.



### <u>Nick Bartolone</u>

Nick Bartolone joins the Oilmen having just completed his freshman season at Butler University.

The Lafayette native saw action in 22 games for Butler, batting .270 in 37 at-bats, ranking 3rd on the team.

At Harrison High School, he set school

records for putouts and chances in the out-

field, and was all-conference in his sopho-

more and junior seasons while leading the

team in batting. He was also a guarterback

and a kicker on the football team.

### <u>Rashawn Tillman</u>

A tremendous athlete with great speed, Tillman comes to Northwest Indiana from SWAC school Arkansas-Pine Bluff, where he redshirted this past season.

Prior to joining the Golden Lions, Tillman played at Laney College in California. The El Soberante native batted .300 there in 33 games with 16 RBI and 22 runs scored in 2012, his freshman season.

### <u>Kenny Mahala</u>

The Highland native had an excellent sophomore year at Heartland Community College, batting .298 with six home runs and 39 RBI, ranking in the top two in both categories on the team.


Nick Saldutti comes to Northwest Indiana from Butler University, where he saw action in 21 games for the Bulldogs.




